The General Services Administration for 35 years employed him in Baltimore, where he retired in 1984. Frank and Gertrude were united in holy matrimony in 1941 in Rocky Mount, NC and moved to Baltimore in the same year 1941. In moving to Baltimore, Frank joined the Mt. Pleasant Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Rev. J. H Tunson, Pastor. Later Frank joined the New Pilgrim Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Rev. W. H. Black where he served as a Male Usher, and traveled around with them until his health began to fail. He loved his church and work. Frank was humble and kind to everyone, to know him was to love him.
