Of all of his children and stepchildren, LaDawn was his earthly angel. She was always there for him whenever needed assisting him even throughout his illness. Frank was an easy-going, fun-loving guy. He loved sports especially baseball and football, his favorites the Baltimore Orioles and the Baltimore Ravens. He like working on cars and tending his garden. Frank had a unique way of making everyone he met just adore him. Frank leaves to cherish fond memories: his two daughters, Christy and Lorraine Eubanks; son, Frank Eubanks Jr.; three stepchildren, Loretta
