



## Fred T. Weldon

September 4, 1911 - November 14, 2002

Fred T. Weldon, born on September 4, 1911 to Nora L. Banks Weldon and John T. Weldon in Scotland, Maryland, was one of fifteen children. He was called to his heavenly home on November 9, 2002. Fred attended and graduated from Cardinal Gibbons Catholic School. After graduating, he helped his family move from St. Mary's County to Washington, D.C. Later, Fred moved to Baltimore and found employment as a stevedore. He worked briefly as a longshoreman before obtaining employment at Western Electric. While at Western Electric, he was drafted into the Navy in 1943, and attained the rank of Boatswain's Mate Second Class. He received an Honorable Discharge in 1945. Upon his discharge, he returned to Western Electric and worked diligently until his retirement in 1976. The joy of his life was the love and devotion shared with the late Edna Weldon, his wife of fifty years. The couple enjoyed their early morning coffee hour, conversation, traveling and entertaining family and friends. A longtime and faithful member of Douglas Memorial Community Church, Fred was active in the outreach ministry at Camp Farthest Out from the time the camp was founded in 1962 until his health prevented him from continuing. During his retirement, he also enjoyed transporting children to and from school. He loved decorating for the holidays and making home repairs. Fred was a dapper and stylish dresser. He is survived by: one sister, Mildred Stewart; three children, Barbara M. Byrd, Loretta R. Rock and reverend Melvin E. Truiett Sr.; a host of grandchildren, great-grandchildren, nieces, nephews, other family members and friends.
