Freddie Rogers Mickles was born to the late Margaret Virginia Mickles and the late Marion Mickles, Sr. on October 21, 1946 in White Stone, VA. He was preceded in death by his two brothers Johnny O. Mickles and William J. Mickles. He was called to be home with the Lord on March 20, 2019.

In 1968 while serving in the Vietnam War, he was wounded and returned home in 1969 where he received a metal for bravery.
