"Freddie" as he was affectionately called by his family & friends enjoyed life and often described himself as a "Man on a Mission." Freddie loved his family, friends, the church, to joke and to laugh. He often made jokes about his "snag-a-tooth" and that when his space-ship lands he is going to take off on it. He loved to eat and after each meal he would say "God bless the cook and the dish washer....Amen" and Amen over-and over- again. Freddie worked at the Steamship Trade Local 333 as a long shore-man and a boss for 35 years. Even after he retired he was still known as "The Boss" or "The Captain" and he still made daily journeys to the hall. Later in life he received the Lord Jesus Christ as his personal Savior and joined Rising Sun Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. James Bull. Bro. Freddie was selected to be a Trustee of the church and he was a devoted member. He was a true missionary of the church. Later he became a faithful member of Silas First Baptist of Severna Park under the leadership of Rev. E. Young, Bro. Freddie came into the church working and making friends easily. He always greeted everyone with his friendly smile and spoke to everyone. He did not mind working in any capacity that was needed at the church. Bro. Freddie would always say "I'm working in the vineyard." He was a missionary, sang on the choir, male choir,

mass choir and the dedication choir. Bro Freddie stood in as a deacon and usher when needed. He was appointed a Trustee as well. He leaves to cherish his memory; three daughters, Kimberly Sanders, Michelle M. and Renita A.
