September 19, 1944 - December 25, 2019

Gary P West was born in New York City on September 19, 1944 to Juious & Elsie West.

Gary spent his life as a resident of Baltimore City. He received his Elementary Education at 453. Gary graduated from City College in 1962. He then joined his father at Bethlehem Steel before pursuing a career in Law Enforcement. In 1966 Gary West would become a Baltimore City Police Officer, where he received many accolades for his outstanding service. He worked tirelessly with the Baltimore Auxiliary Police Unit which provided law-abiding civilians an opportunity to serve in supporting rolls in order to assist law enforcement and Sgt Gary P West was recognized for his exemplary work with this unit. He met the Love of his life Joyce Marie Graves and they would go on to Wed on September 16, 1967 and spent the next 52 years together up until his untimely death. In 1984 He was promoted to Sgt. Gary West before retiring in 1996. In 1982 Gary graduated from Baltimore City Community College with a degree in Criminal Justice.

Gary had an affinity for motorcycles and purchased himself a shiny Black & Chrome Big Boy Harley Davidson. That bike was his pride and joy. You could find him outside polishing it on any given day. Riding gave him a feeling of being free. He joined a local Harley Davidson bike club where he and his wife would ride out with a convoy of other bikers.

Gary also developed a passion for photography and took his job very seriously. He was the resident photographer and on the scene at all of the

family functions. Gary published pictures and articles in one of Baltimore's local magazine "Impressions" owned by Harold Robinson. You couldn't tell Gary he wasn't a freelance photographer. He also published the "TGS" Family's Newsletters. "West" as he was affectionately called was known as the life of the party. He was very popular in his social scene where he was known as "The Picture Man".

Gary Pedro West departed life unexpectedly in his home on December 25, 2019.
