



Genevieve (Jean) H. Wilson

January 22, 1915 - July 2, 2002

Genevieve H. Wilson was born and raised in Memphis Tennessee. Upon completion from high school, she attended Lemoyne College. She worked as a Disc Jockey in the late 1940s and early 1950s in St. Louis, before transferring to Chicago to work as the national advertising sales representative for Johnson Publications. In 1956, she married Kenneth O. Wilson and in 1963, the couple moved and settled in Baltimore. Together with her husband, Mrs. Wilson was co-owner of the Inner Harbor Marina of Baltimore. She proudly served on several boards, including the Baltimore Chapter of the American Red Cross, Center Stage, the Maryland Family and Children's Society and the Keswick Multi-Care Center. Also, Mrs. Wilson was an active member of the NAACP and the Providence Baptist Church adult day care center. In 1977, she was appointed by President Jimmy Carter to the National Advisory Committee of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention. She served in this position until 1981. In addition to her husband, she is survived by two grandsons, eleven great-grandchildren, two great-great-grandchildren and her Providence Baptist Church Family. Graveside services and interment will be held in Memphis, Tennessee.
