



## Geoffrey Njinjo Chege

Geoffrey Njinjo Chege was born February 2, 1955 in Nairobi Kenya, the second of ten children, to the union of the late Stanley and Alice Njeri Chege. He was called to heaven December 3, 2017.

Geoffrey was brought up and educated in Kenya. After his high school education, he enrolled in the Kiganjo Police College. He joined the police force in 1976 and was a dedicated officer for 29 years. Geoffrey retired from the Police force in 2005.

During his police career he began to race as a speed walker. Later he trained the police force runners. He also worked with the United Nations as a Peace Keeper in Cambodia. Geoffrey retired from the police force as an inspector. He was an avid runner and grew into a passionate Olympic-level Track and Field Coach. Through coaching he traveled extensively across the world.

He married Victoria Mose July 29, 1982. From their union they brought four children into their world. Geoffrey was a loving husband and father. In the early '90s he traveled to the United States to be with his family. In 2008, he relocated to the United States permanently. In his time here, he graduated from a three year Theology Program from Faith Landmark. He was devoted a Christian and a missionary with the Miracle Community Christianity Centre. He also worked for G4S.

Geoffrey was preceded in death by his brother, Johnson Mwangi.
