GEORGE AUGUSTUS ADAMS was born on May 22, 1929 in Baltimore, Maryland to the late Clinton and Clara Adams. He was the seventh child of nine from this union. George was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System.

George was a member of the First Apostolic Church where several of his family members still attend. He met and married Alma C. Sledge on February 2, 1947 and from this union there were four children.

George was a long time employee of the Amtrak Rail System (formerly Penn Central Railroad) and later in his career there he became a railroad track foreman. He later retired from Amtrak due to health reasons.

During the early 1980's George suffered a series of strokes that left him challenged but not defeated. In spite of this he showed a strong determination to remain independent. He particularly enjoyed taking daily walks until he was physically unable to do so.
