GEORGE NORMAN BROWN, son of the late Thornton and Maggie Brown, was born on September 8, 1921 in Baltimore, Maryland . He departed this life to take on heavenly wings on Wednesday, October 5, 2011 after an extended illness.

“Norman” attended school in Baltimore and completed his education in Virginia at the Ensor Shop School.

Norman began his Christian journey at an early age and was baptized in September of 1934 at the Ebenezer Baptist Church in Virginia.

Norman served in the United States Army in 1943 and was honorably discharged.
