George Franklin Davis, also known as "Cheetah", departed this earthly life after a brief illness on Wednesday, April 6, 2022. He was the second of six children born to the late Phenel and Ethel Davis in Drakes Branch, Virginia. He was preceded in death by his beloved wife, Delores Antoinette Davis; two younger brothers, Ernest Davis (aka "Pug") and Leslie Davis.

George's parents moved from Drakes Branch to Richmond when he was 10 years old where they lived in the Church Hill area of the city. George accepted Christ at an early age in Drakes Branch and joined St. Paul's Baptist Church in Henrico County later in life. George was extremely proud of his over 1 million miles safe driving record and could often be seen wearing his jackets that displayed his impressive driving records and achievements.

As he grew his fleet of classic cars, he joined the Richmond Metropolitan Antique Car Club where he served as Chapter Treasurer for many years. He enjoyed the camaraderie of the club often participating in many of the club parades. He later became a member of the Street Dreams Cruisers club where he developed many deep, lifelong friendships with several club members. George's sharp wit, warm smile, and kind spirit naturally drew people to him. Conversations with him were never short, and he loved a good laugh. He was a good friend to many and he was a good husband, father, brother, uncle, and cousin to his extended family . He will be greatly missed by all who knew him.

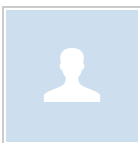
