A Life Well Lived:

George William Gaines

George William Gaines was born to the late William Douglas and Annie Louvenia Gaines on August 17, 1920. He was the oldest of seven children—Charles, Alfred, Mamie, Martha, Dorothy, and Sterling. Born in Centreville, Maryland, George attended the public schools of Queen Anne's County, Maryland. He attended the Bethel A. M. E. Church until his marriage to Frances P. Edmonds in 1952. Of this marriage was born one son, George, Jr., whose marriage to Delcina gave George his dearly loved grandson, Shawn.

In 1967 George became a member of Union Baptist Church that he served as a member of The Men's League and a bus driver for The Lott Carey Youth Seminar, the Junior Church Hershy Park trips, and the Young Adult Choir trips, as well as The Men's League Retreat. He was an active member of The Sunshine Circle. A constant worshipper in his beloved church and his preferred pew, George was named The 2016 Union Baptist Church Man of the Year. Even until this past late fall, George remained a constant and generous supporter of Union Baptist Church, its programs and its ministries.

His career began as an automobile mechanic in his father's garage and continued until retirement. He owned and operated his own school bus which

he operated for Queen Anne's County Schools for more than 50 years. At his retirement he was recognized for his driving for the school system for more than 1.2 million miles without ever receiving a citation.

Goerge William Gaines served during World War II with the 90th Anti-Aircraft Battalion. He was the first Afro-American to cross the Rhine River. He lived as a model of his motto: "Getting the credit is not important. Getting the job done well is".

George W. Gaines leaves to mourn his wife, Frances; his son, George, Jr, daughter-in-law-Delcina, one grandson Shawn, a and sister, Dorothy Pauls. He leaves, as well, nieces, nephews, a host of relatives, and loving friends.

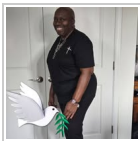

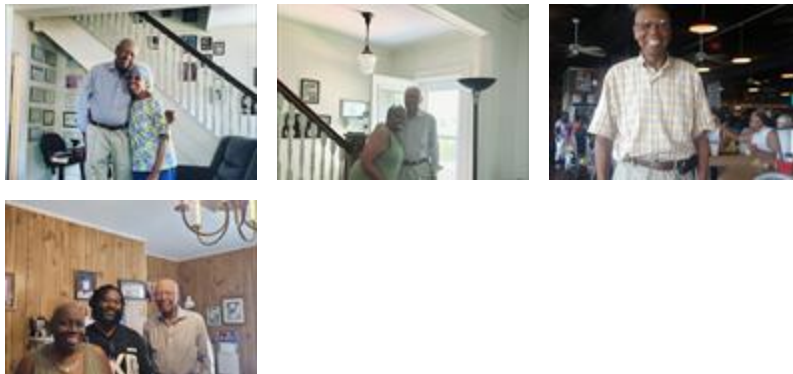
