GEORGE LEE GRIFFIN JR., SON OF THE LATE GEORGE LEE GRIFFIN SR. AND SHIRLEY JOHNSTON, WAS BORN ON JANUARY 22, 1960 IN WILMINGTON, NORTH CAROLINA IN COMMUNITY HOSPITAL. AT THE AGE OF FIVE, HIS MOTHER RELOCATED THE FAMILY TO BALTIMORE, MARYLAND WHERE HE RESIDED FOR THE REST OF HIS LIFE. HE WAS CALLED HOME TO GOD ON FEBRUARY 25, 2017 A FIVE YEAR BATTLE WITH CANCER.

GEORGE JR. RECEIVED HIS HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA IN 1979 AT FREDERICK SR. HIGH SCHOOL WHERE HE RECEIVED HIS CERTIFICATION IN MAINTENANCE AND PLUMBING AT A LOCAL TRADE SCHOOL WHICH LEAD HIM TO BE A MAINTENANCE MAN AT MULTIPLE APARTMENT COMPLEXES.

GEORGE HAD MULTIPLE SKILLS SUCH AS PAINTING, DRAWING, SEWING AND PLAYING HIS GUITAR. HE WAS A GUITAR PLAYER IN AN R&B AND FUNK BAND CALLED AIR RAID. HE ALSO PLAYED THE GUITAR AT WILSON PARK CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY CHURCH ON SOME OCCASIONS.

MOST OF ALL HE LOVED WOMEN AND HIS BEER. GEORGE WAS ONE OF THE SHARPEST DRESSERS IN BALTIMORE CITY.
