August 26, 1946 - February 16, 2007

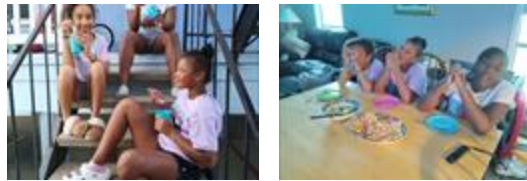

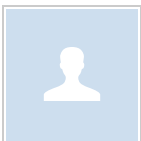
