George Randall was born on July 5, 1929 in Chestertown, Maryland. He was one of two children born to Zeneda Randall. He departed this life on Friday, November 23, 2018 at the Season's Hospice at Sinai Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland.

George was educated in the Germantown School system in Philadelphia. In 1943 he continued and completed his education in Denton, Maryland located on the Eastern shore where he also won a scholarship to college.

In the fall of 1947 George entered College with help of his Aunt Hannah. He completed his education in the spring of 1952. In November of that same year George was drafted into the military. He served as a core man or army medic at Fort Lenoardwood, Missouri. He was honorably discharged in 1954.
