George E. Washington, affectionately known as “Daddy George,” was born March 29, 1919, son of the late Tom and Margaret Scroggins. George transitioned this life to a higher plane on June 28, 2004 at the Maryland Veteran Administration Hospital due to a short term illness. He received his education in the Annapolis Public School System, attending the Bates Senior High School. At the early age of eighteen, he began his employment at the Bethlehem Steel Plant at the Sparrows Point Shipyard. In June of 1944, he was drafted into the United States Naval Service. He faithfully served his country during World War II and was honorably discharged in January 1946. Upon completing his service to the United States Armed Forces, he resumed his employment at Sparrows Point until retirement. On December 15, 1940, George was united in holy matrimony to Naomi Corrine Byrd. From this union, one daughter, Anne Iona Washington was born. Daddy George, a loving husband, father and grandfather had a passion for children and the community which became his life-long joy and his key to happiness. He leaves his memories to be cherished by three grandchildren, Bryant Washington, Dwan and Crystal Monroe-Bey; one son-in-law, Ellsworth (Latif) Monroe-Bey; one granddaughter-in-law, La Verne Washington; four great-grandchildren, Ami, Kiona, Lil’Will and Cameron; a special friend, Mr. Thayer Robinson; and a host of other relatives and friends.
