



## George Washington Thomas

August 7, 1913 - September 29, 2001

George Washington Thomas, Sr., son of the late James Thomas and Julia Mae Drumwright Thomas, was born August 7, 1913 in Woodsdale, North Carolina. He departed on September 29, 2001 at the age of eighty-eight. George was educated in Woodsdale, North Carolina. In 1941 George was united in holy matrimony to Ann Louise Butler and raised eight children. He served combat duty in the U.S. Army in Europe and the South Pacific during World War II where he received the WWII Victory Ribbon, the Asiatic Liberation Ribbon and the Pacific Liberation Ribbon. Bethlehem Steel Corp employed him as a longshoreman, crane operator and rigger from 1943 until his retirement in 1973. During his life, George was well known for the help he gave relatives and friends through hard times. He leaves four of his eight children to carry on the family, Deliphenia Ferguson, Bilal Omar, Julia Green, Ruth Jackson, and a host of other relatives.
