George Wylie Woodson was born on November 9, 1931 to Lillian White and Wylie Woodson in Baltimore, MD. During his childhood years, George was raised by his mother and Aunt Amanda. On his mom's side of the family, George had his grandparents, Charles Evans and Margarett White who migrated from Fredericksburg, VA to Middle River, MD. He also had two aunts, Eleanor Grant and Amanda White, and an uncle, Willie White who all lived in Baltimore. On his father's side of the family, George grandparents were Van and Mary Wade Woodson. He also had six uncles, Howard, Robert, Van, James, John and Walker Woodson and an aunt, Edith Swann who all lived in Baltimore.

George attended Baltimore City Public Schools. After high school, George entered and served in the United States Army and served in the Korean War. While being stationed at Fort Leavenworth, MI in 1954, George received an Honorable Discharge from the military, and returned to Baltimore. On March 29, 1958, George married Lillie Mae Frieson. Together they raised four children, Sandra, Chauncey, Joyce and Eric.

George was an active member of his community and a hard worker. Before his retirement on February 11, 1995, he worked for Continental Can Company (Later Crown Cork and Seal) for forty-two years. There he rendered his service as a machinist and union representative. In 1960, he joined Berea

Lutheran Church, where he served as the church treasurer. For many years, George was also active as a Prince Hall Mason. George loved to work outside in his yard. He took great pride in caring for his grass, bushes and flowers and received a community award for his work. George was also an avid sports fan, cheering on his beloved Baltimore Orioles and Baltimore Ravens.

George leaves to cherish his memory, his wife Lillie Mae Woodson, sons Chauncey Woodson and Eric Woodson, and daughter Joyce Woodson. His daughter Sandra Johnson preceded him in death in 2013. His five grandchildren include, Kiandra Ebony Johnson, Kala Joi Nelson, Tara Ann Woodson, Leah Mae Woodson and Eric Daniel Woodson. He has one great granddaughter, Amaiya Smith.
