He was employed at “New England Baptist Hospital” for a period of two years as a Respiratory Technician. Gerald the moved on to “Westinghouse” as an Electronic Technician for twenty-nine years; where he earned many awards and citations for his exemplary work and ingenuity. He

was given monetary awards for his ideas that were patented.

He enjoyed being home with his family later on in life and frequently visited Jamaica. Gerald was well liked by many; even those who loved to hate him.
