Geraldine Sylvia (Fields) Beasley was born October 12, 1923, in Baltimore, Maryland. She was called home to be with the Lord on the morning of September 4, 2012.

Geraldine was the last surviving of the ten children of Lafayette and Rosa fields. Her parents and all of her nine siblings preceded her in death. Geraldine was raised on West Lanvale Street. She received her education through the Baltimore City Public School System, where she was a graduating member of the class of 1941 from Frederick Douglass High School.

She married the late Clarence E. Beasley on March 15, 1941. They were married for 50 years. Of this union, four children were born, two of which preceded her in death: Sylvia A. Garland, her daughter and her son Everett K. Beasley. She also had a step-daughter Alice Doughty (deceased). She is survived by her two remaining children: Shirley I. Bailey and Michael G. Beasley.

After raising her family, Geraldine went to work for the United States Postal Service. Prior to retiring in 1989, she worked there for 23 years. Geraldine was baptized at Orchard Street Methodist Church, now named Metropolitan United Methodist Church where she was a lifelong member. Honorably, she marched with the congregation from Old Orchard Street Church to

Metropolitan's previous location at Carrolton Avenue, and to our current location Lanvale Street. Geraldine enjoyed being a member of MUMC, visiting with family, friends and neighbors. Her other interests included: bible trivia, reading, geography, eating home cooked meals, and an occasional cruise trip.

Geraldine leaves to cherish her memory two children: Shirley Bailey and Michael Beasley; granddaughters, Donna Tucker and Chantinique Brown; grandsons, William (Stephanie) Bailey and Blake Jeter; great-grandchildren, Dominique Tucker, Candace (Damon) Parker, Sydney Bailey, and Seth Bailey; and a host of nieces and nephews.
