



## Geraldine Raymond Wesley

November 12, 1929 - April 24, 2004

Geraldine R. Wesley was born in Baltimore, Maryland on November 12, 1929. She was the oldest of three children born to Nathaniel and Leona Raymond. She was educated in Baltimore City schools, later became a licensed cosmetologist and also served as a faithful State employee for 30 years. On August 3, 1948, she married her beloved John R. Wesley and from this union five children were born. Geraldine was a highly family-oriented person—"the glue" that kept them all together. Her organizational skills were exceptional and her energy and vitality was second to none. She was affectionately known by her family and friends, young and old alike, as "Poom-Poom." In addition to her ministry, she greatly enjoyed traveling and camping. She was also a "shop 'til you drop" energizer bunny, counting her shopping partners as "pitiful." Geraldine was dedicated to Jehovah and baptized in 1970. She served Jehovah zealously as a regular pioneer (attending Pioneer School with enthusiasm), as an auxiliary pioneer and as a regular publisher, until the end of her life. She captured the interest of many because she showed a great deal of interest in others. She loved Jehovah with all her heart and believed in His promises. Geraldine Wesley is survived by her husband of 55 wonderful years, John R. Wesley; one sister, Ethel Steele; four children, Patricia L. Hopson, Barbara A. Fleming (John R. Wesley, Jr. preceded her in death), Marian A. Laster, Kenneth Gerald Wesley; and her "adopted daughter" and friend, Juanita Owens. She also leaves to mourn: two sons-in-law, Roy Hopson and Lester Fleming; one daughter-in-law, Margaret R. Wesley (Cissy)
