July 4, 1954 - May 29, 2018

GLEN RANDOLPH SCOTT, son of the late Daisy and Harry Scott, was born on July 4, 1954 in Baltimore, MD. On Tuesday, May 29, 2018, God dispatched an angel from heaven to bring his beloved son home.

Glen gave his life to Christ at an early age, and was baptized at St. Ann Catholic Church. Later in his walk in life, Glen joined Saint Francis Catholic Church to further his relationship with the Lord. On any given day, you could find Glen reading the word of God which gave him comfort. One of his favorite scripture was Luke 12:48. "To whom much is given, much is required"

Glen was a generous man who gave much of his time to help others he was a wise man, would freely share his wisdom and knowledge with all who knew him Glen was a great cook!

Glen's passion, however, was sports and being active outdoors whether it was working in the garden or skiing. He played semi pro football as both a nose tackle and linebacker for several teams and on October 21, 1994, he was inducted into Frostburg State University (F. S. U.) Hall of Fame. Glen was one of the greatest defensive tackles in F. S.U. history. At 6'3", 225 pounds, he had the quickness and speed of a running back. Such prowess and God-given ability earned him both All NAIA District Tackle in 1976 and Team Most Valuable Player in 1976 and 1977. Glen was Frostburg State's greatest football player during the mid-1970s. Often a "One-man" gang who was all

over the field on defense, playing on teams which was usually young and generally unsuccessful.

Glen went to Frost State university on a football scholarship and played all four years. He graduated with a bachelors degree in Political Science in 1978. Between playing semi-pro football. Glen worked for Eastern Ski Tours and Eastern Stainless Steel before starting his own home remodeling business.

Glen is preceded in death by his son, Glen Randolph Johnson (Fingers), and his brothers, Brian, Jackie and Keith Scott. Glen leaves to cherish his memory; two loving daughters, Chuanta' and Ja'Nae Scott; two sons, Garen and GaVante Green -Scott; step daughter, Shavia Green; four grandsons, Devonte' Jones Colvin Jones, Kaiden Green-Scott and Ashton Green Scott' five granddaughters, Tyjah Sellers-Stubbs, Aniyah Payne, Aliyah Jones Amirah Jones Payton Green-Scott; two sisters Delores Carter (Princess) and La'Shore (Boobie); two brothers, Russell and Leonard Scott (Woody); a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends
