Mr. Glenn Logan, the son of Clarence W. Logan, Sr. and Berneda F. Logan, was born June 10, 1952 at the Baltimore City Hospitals. On July 2, 2002, while at home, Glenn peacefully departed this life. Glenn attended the Baltimore City Public Schools. After completing the Paul Lawrence Dunbar High School, he joined the United States Army, from which he would later receive an honorable discharge. Following his discharge from the Army, Glenn was employed by Brown's Supermarket. During this time, he obtained his certification as a meat cutter. In August 1978, Glenn joined the Giant Food family, where he continued to be employed until his illness necessitated his retirement. Glenn was baptized at an early age by the late Reverend Moses Williams at the Zion Baptist Church, where he served on the Usher Board, in addition to being active in the Boy Scouts of America. Glenn loved to share his fond memories and many stories concerning the stellar accomplishments of Dunbar Senior High athletes. He especially revered Dunbar's legendary coach, William "Sugar" Cain. He maintained his love of sports throughout his lifetime. Glenn was married to Brenda D. Brown and from this union one daughter was born, Dana M. Murrell.
