



## Gloria June Bryant

June 15, 1930 - January 30, 2015

GLORIA JEAN BRYANT, daughter of the late Zelda Dorsey-Gosnell and Nicholas James Gosnell, was born June 15, 1930 in Baltimore, Maryland. On Friday, January 30, 2015, after a brief illness, she departed from worldly labor to eternal life with Almighty Gd.

Gloria was one of five children, educated at Carver Vocational High School in Baltimore City as a seamstress in dressmaking in 1948. In 1949, Gloria married Frank E. Bryant, Sr. and from this union four children were born. For over 20 years Gloria and Frank traveled many places with their children because of Frank's military service in the U.S. Army. Gloria was a devoted wife and mother to her family as a homemaker, and loved sewing, gardening, and cooking delicious meals.

After military life, Gloria and family settled back in Baltimore, Maryland to be close to family and friends. She often had gatherings at her home for meals and fellowship. Gloria worked various jobs in Baltimore and settled with providing daycare for the children in the family, neighbors and friends. She lived for family and lovingly cared for her mother, Zelda, for many years.

Gloria had a cheerful countenance and greeted all with a hug and kiss. She was frequently called Mom by friends, neighbors and her church family at Trailblazer's International Christian Center. Her love for the Lord inspired her

to encourage others in their path to follow after our Lord and Savior Christ Jesus. This journey for her became a precious blessing to her family and friends. She was fondly called Gloria Hallelujah as a child by her uncle Richard and Uncle Hence when she visited the Dorsey family farm in Howard County.

She leaves to cherish her memory: her brother, Morris Gosnell; four children, Valerie McGhee, Angela Carroll, Frank Bryant Jr., and Kathleen Kenny; son-in-law, Tyrone Carroll; daughter-in-law, Brenda Bryant; and a host of grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and other relatives and friends.

Her brothers, James Clifton Gosnell, Calvin Eugene Gosnell, and Charles Bernard Gosnell preceded her in death.
