During this time she was a member of the Eastern Star, a registered member of the Native American Indians and a registered markswomen; just a few of her many accomplishments.

As a young women she worked beside her brother, the late William Chowder Pleasants and Sis. Julia in their privately owned restaurant and bar. Taking that experience and knowledge with her husband, the late William Ellis, she became the proprietor of Tommy Tucker Concession in Edmonson Village during the 1980s.

Active in foster care and the concerns with family and friends her doors were always open.. As a visionary, Goldia lived her family no matter how extended. She made sure that her love, patience, understanding, protection and unconditional love was felt.
