



## Gordon Goldsborough

May 15, 1936 - April 9, 2020

GORDON ELSWORTH GOLDSBOROUGH, the only child of the late James Young and Bessie Lee Goldsborough, was born May 15, 1936 in Baltimore, Maryland. Gordon was educated in the public schools of Baltimore and graduated from Douglass High School in 1955.

Gordon enlisted in the United States Air Force in October 1955. He spent his early military service being stationed on various bases in Texas, Wyoming, Illinois, Massachusetts and Germany.

In December of 1960 he returned home to Baltimore to marry Virginia Blackwell. They were then stationed to North Dakota. There they welcomed the birth of the first child; Anthony. Several years later they were stationed to Turkey where they welcomed their second child; Laurie.

After a couple of years, they were stationed to Germany where he took his family on many sightseeing trips and vacations.

His last station was in Nebraska where he retired from the Air Force and returned home to Baltimore, Maryland.

He began his civilian career working in different federal organizations; the Federal Bureau of Investigations, U.S. Customs and lastly, the Secret Service

where he retired from the work force.

Gordon loved listening to jazz, going sight seeing and fishing. He had many "gone fishing" weekends with his friends. He also enjoyed "dropping in" on his family and friends and "signify".
