As soon as anyone stepped through the door, she offered them a meal. Before they left, she always said, "I have something for you. Get that Watch Tower on your way out."

Listening to Jehovah's Witness music was a favorite past-time. But hosting family gatherings and cookouts also brought her tremendous joy. She really enjoyed learning line dances from her children and grands. She'd lift that one shoulder and "slide to the left, then slide to the right" with her cane in hand.
