Grace's deep love for her grandchildren and great-grandchildren made her proud to discuss their accomplishments in school and physical achievement. She loved having lawn parties, barbecues

and family gatherings inviting the whole neighborhood. Grace disliked flying in airplanes, but enjoyed motor trip vacations and cruises. Shopping at thrift stores were her Macy's, Sears and Hecht Company. She would copy designs in major stores and complete them with material from thrift markets.
