



## Greg Taylor

December 12, 1967 - May 11, 2022

Greg Taylor, age 54, was born December 12, 1967, in Bronx, New York, to Collie Taylor-Ferguson and the late Joseph M. Taylor. His father, Willis T. Ferguson, and grandmother, Beatrice E. Williams, preceded him in death. He peacefully transitioned from earthly labor to heavenly reward on May 11, 2022.

Greg was educated in the Richmond Public School System and graduated from Armstrong High School. After high school, he went into the Navy to become a maintenance technician on Active Duty for four years. After his stint on Active Duty, he did some reserve time in the Navy. Greg also attained a certification in welding.

Greg met his true love, Angela, while working at Lowes. He worked in the back of the store as the receiving and shipping manager. She worked in the front of the store at the customer service desk. One day Angela's voice came across the intercom, and Greg heard her. He looked at his friend, Ivan, and said, "that girl has the voice of an angel; one day, I'm going to marry her." Indeed, he married her four years later, on January 6, 2018, in her hometown of South Boston, Va.

He gave his life to Christ as an adult on October 25, 1995, at the First Union Baptist Church of Richmond, Va. Greg worked in shipping and receiving at Lowes for twenty-plus years. He worked in several logistics positions over his

adult years. Greg was an avid car mechanic for friends and family, where he would work on everyone car he came across. He enjoyed "barbequing," refereeing and umpiring, and backyard horseshoes. He was a boxing enthusiast and loved playing basketball and tennis and riding his motorcycle. He was caring, loving, compassionate, kind, and devoted to his immediate family and all who knew him. He had a heart of gold. If you needed anything, he would meet you where you were to help you and give you his last because; he never wanted to see you without anything.

He was a devoted "Dallas Cowboys" fan. He had a cheerful laugh and joyful personality that will always be remembered. He was the "King of Trash-Talking" and always wanted to play practical jokes on his family and friends.
