He began as a Patient Escort, transporting patients to their various appointments throughout the hospital. Through the years, he worked hard and rose to the position of Manager of Escort Services. In 2008, Greg retired from Johns Hopkins Hospital after 42 years of employment.

He would invite the guys over to eat crabs, drink beer, listen to music, and talk a lot of trash. He loved baseball and cheering for his favorite football team – The Baltimore Ravens.

Greg was the carefree brother. He thought of himself as a “Ladies Man.” He nicknamed himself “the Bean” and “the Lover.” Greg loved to dance. He had no shame in being the first one on the dance floor but had no rhythm. It was embarrassing to watch, but so much fun. We will miss him.
