Gregory Jonathan Cooper, son of the late Sherwood and Muriel Gross Cooper was born on June 21, 1955 in Baltimore, Maryland. He departed this life on June 16, 2017 after a lengthy illness.

He received his education in the New York Public School System and also received higher education at Hunter College in New York and Morgan State University in Baltimore, MD. At the age of 21, Gregory began working in the Emergency Room of the Beth Israel Hospital in New York City. He later moved to Glen Burnie, MD where he worked at Plaza Manor Nursing Home. His career in the medical field led him to work for Mercy Hospital and The Johns Hopkins Hospital. He retired from Sinai hospital after working 18 years in the Emergency Room, Operating Room, and Catheter Laboratory.
