GWENDOLYN MORRIS, daughter of the late Mary Anderson and William Baker, was born on August 1, 1922 in St. James, Jamaica, West Indies. She departed this life on October 2, 2010.

Gwendolyn received her education through the Rowe Hampton All Age School in St. James, Jamaica. She migrated to the United States in the 1980's, where she worked domestically for several years until she retired to take care of her family.

Gwendolyn loved shopping, cooking and taking care of her family. She often considered the comedian of the family because she could make you laugh no matter how bad your day was going.

On November 7, 1958, she married Astley Nathaniel Morris. From this union they had thirteen beloved children, fifty-six grandchildren, fifty-five great-grandchildren and eleven great-great-grandchildren.

Gwendolyn accepted Jesus Christ at a very young age at the Lake's Penn Apostolic Church in Jamaica. When she migrated to the United States she attended Grace Temple under the pastorate of Minister Astan Miller.

Gwendolyn later joined New Life Pentecostal Ministries under the leadership of Bishop Roan S. Faulkner.

Left to cherish her legacy are: her sisters , Eula Lee-Jones and Rhoda Jones; her children, Joyce Morris-Wray, Ruth Morris-Rowe, Mervin Morris, Norma Morris-Forest (deceased), Norma Norris-Crooks, Zenie Morris-Walker, Ralph Morris, Winston Alexander Morris, Petunia Venice Morris, Donald Andrew Morris and Lincoln Horace Morris. And that you're proud of me.*

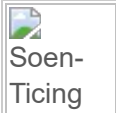
