HAMPTON CAMPBELL, JR., son of the late Hampton Sr. and Zelma Campbell, was born on October 26, 1928 in Amherst, Virginia. He departed this life on June 13, 2019 after a lengthy illness.

Hampton received his education in the public schools of Amherst, Virginia. He enlisted in the United States Navy on November 14, 1945, where he served for 2 years receiving the World War II Victory Metal. He was honorably discharged on July 8, 1946.

Hampton met and married the former Peggy Coltrane in 1950, and out of this union two sons were born, Ricky and Steve. He was a good husband and father, who never wanted his sons to leave home.
