



Mr. Harly Johnson

July 16, 1932 - March 1, 2012

Harly Johnson, son of the late William M. and Hattie Floyd Johnson, was born on July 16, 1932, in Tabor City, North Carolina. He departed this life on March 1, 2012 after a lengthy illness. He was preceded in death by his wife, June Marilyn Johnson, his only grandson, Harly Anthony Johnson, 8 brothers; Wilford, George, Richard, Edward, Chesley, Frank, Roosevelt, M.C., Pernell, and one sister; Janie Johnson Richardson.

Harly received his education in the Tabor City Public School System. He attended St. Mathews A.M.E. Church, where he accepted Christ at an early age. When not in church, his favorite pastime was shooting marbles; his worse pastime was working in the fields with his family.

In January 1951, after following his brother George to Baltimore, he met and married June M. Anthony, (also known as Little Teeney). From this union, one son was born, Leonard Anthony Johnson.

Harly, known to his friends as "Red Eye", held multiple jobs after coming to Baltimore. He served in the U.S. Army and was honorably discharged after two years. After the Army, he worked for Boston Metal, the Shipyard and after leaving the shipyard, he worked for the Maryland State Highway Administration where he retired after twenty-five years of service as a Maintenance Technician. The time, his favorite pastime changed to partying,

pinochle, and fishing (with the emphasis on fishing.) Anything he caught that was bigger than a pack of cigarettes, he kept and cooked.

Harly leaves to cherish his memory, his only son, Leonard Anthony Johnson; his sister, Hattie Kearney, of Tabor City, NC; one sister-in-law, Equilla; one step brother, Arthur; and a host of cousins, nieces, nephews, great nieces, great nephews, and friends in Baltimore, Tabor City, NC and Philadelphia.
