“ I learned only recently of the transition of my friend, fellow alumnus and former colleague at Morgan State University, Dr. Harmon Watson. Harmon graduated from Morgan State College in 1966, two years before me, and was one of our outstanding theater arts majors. As an undergraduate at Morgan, I stood in awe of his creative talents and achievements. During his undergraduate years, he wrote a trilogy of short plays that were performed during Morgan’s Centennial Celebration in 1966-67. He joined the faculty of Morgan in 1968 (the semester after my graduation) and served as instructor and assistant professor of theater for 18 years, minus two years, when he took leave of absence to do further graduate work. Dr. Watson was one of the creative arts luminaries at Morgan for nearly two decades, following in the footsteps of his mentors, Professor Arthur Lamb and Dr. Waters E. Turpin, and his presence is still felt by the many students who studied under him at Morgan. I served with him on Morgan’s faculty from 1970 to 1986, when he joined the faculty of Fayetteville State University, whose gain of him was certainly Morgan’s great loss. Both institutions enjoyed the dedicated service of one of the major theater arts educators of our time. His former Morgan colleagues and I will truly miss him, and we will remain forever grateful for his nearly-two decades of service as playwright and educator at his alma mater.
