Struggling with his illness, at times he would be a little difficult to bear, but she still showed up whether to take him to his doctor's appointment or bring him something to eat, she was right there. Harold had three dear neighbors that he was good friends with; Dr. Martina Callum (Doc) as he called her, Juan Quintanilla (Tony) and Charles Mason. The four of them would also sit on Mama's front porch and have a good time laughing. Mama's front porch was definitely the place to be.

He had a special bond with his old neighborhood. Harold grew up living on Greenmount Avenue for decades. Although, he moved away many years ago, nothing could stop him from visiting his old neighborhood quite frequently. Even through his illness, you could find him down the way (as he called it) any given day. He will definitely be missed by all who knew him.

He was preceded in death by three sisters, Ester (Sis), Mary (Helen), and Brenda; and two brothers, James (Doc) and William (Hawkeye).
