March 6, 1943 - March 17, 2016

HARRY JAMES DOUGLAS BRIDGES (73), a faithful servant of the Lord, passed on March 17, 2016. Harry affectionately known as “Brick”, was born March 6, 1943 in Pageland, South Carolina to Clyde Bridges and Lois Crawford- Bridges.

Harry spent his early childhood in Kannapolis, North Carolina, where he attended elementary school and was a member of the honor roll throughout elementary school. The family moved to Maryland in 1956 where he attended Sollers Point High School in Baltimore County. There, he was an academic scholar and athlete, where he played basketball and ran track. The family moved to Baltimore City where he graduated from Dunbar High School. Harry earned an Associate of Arts degree in Human Services from Baltimore City Community College and Bachelor of Social Work/ Social degree from Coppin State University.

Harry was known for his community outreach. His first love was to reach out and help someone. He truly knew the meaning of sacrifice; he fought for civil rights, job discrimination, and the poor.

He was a member of Cordoza Adams Lodge #19 AFTAM and a past member of the Liberty Medical Mental Health Board. He was a former executive board member of the council 92 AFSCME AFL-CIO and University of Maryland

Hospital Local 1694 unions. He was a member of Bethel AME Church where he volunteered for the prison ministry, hospitality committee, the Saturday homeless soup kitchen, and was former president of the gospel choir. He was a committed member of the Berea Neighborhood Association where he fought for his community.

Indeed, he fought a good fight and now he can rest because of his noble, virtuous work.

At the end of his faithful journey Harry leaves: his brother Charles Bridges Sr. of Mount Joy, PA; his nephew Charles Bridges Jr. and his wife Alicia; his great-niece Kayla and Great-nephew Ethan. He also leaves behind three beloved aunts, Artis Shine, Patricia Crawford, and Bernice Crawford, close cousins; and a host of other relatives and friends too countless to name. He will be dearly missed.
