December 14, 1927 - May 5, 2020

Harry Emmanuel Eppes was the sixth child out of ten, born to the late Lazarus James Epps and Helen Virginia Stokes-Epps in Prince Edward County Virginia on December 14th, 1927. He departed this life peacefully on May 5, 2020.

At a young age, Harry received his Christian fellowship and baptism at Levi Baptist Church in Green Bay, Virginia. He relocated to Baltimore, Maryland with his family at the age of seven.

On March 12, 1946, Harry enlisted in the United States Army where he served in World War II. He received an honorable discharge for his military service. Upon returning to the states, Harry entered the workforce as a truck driver for Bethlehem Steel. He retired after 34 years of service.

Harry loved to travel, fish and hunt small game. He was always thoughtful in his actions, keeping the needs (and wants) of his friends and family in mind. With a wonderful smile and a big generous heart, his dependability and kindness touched the lives of everyone in his community.

He leaves to cherish his memory: two siblings, James and Shirley, and seven siblings preceded him in death. His legacy includes fourteen children: Althea, Willie Mae, Willie Lee (Deceased), Nannie Mae (Deceased), Peggy, Harry,
