HARRY YOUNG, JR. was born in Baltimore, MD on May 8, 1940 to Inez and Harry Young, Sr. He departed the physical form on January 4, 2008 in Birmingham, Alabama. He was an alumnus of Dunbar High School, class of 1958. Before establishing his legendary music career, he was employed at Westinghouse and Sparrow Point Steel Mills in Baltimore, MD. His outstanding dedication and contributions as editor of the "NiteLife" editorial of the Birmingham Times spoke for itself. He was affectionately known as "Doc Soul Stirrer" by his many fans, peers and proteges globally. He was a master musician, entertainer, journalist and humanitarian. He is considered an icon in the pantheon of great musicians from Baltimore, Maryland. He is remembered by friends and family as a kind, generous enough to be a part of his inner circle. He leaves to celebrate his life: three sons, Kirk and Michael Young and Omar Akbar; two daughters, Diana Young Shelton and Tyra Young Chaney; ten grandchildren, Kirk Young, Jr. Teonatae Peoples, Antonio Peoples, Tania Peoples, Hasaun Young, Cushanah Young, Dylaun, Mikai and Kayliss Young and RaKhem Atem; five great-grandchildren, Tre'Quaniek, Janera, Kameran and Ja'Yon, who preceded him in death, as well as Kemmonie; one surviving sister, Attrices Griffin; a host of close friends, along with Alicia, Diane and Lorraine. 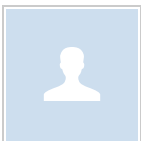
