February 28, 1905 - November 25, 2001

Hattie Irene Banks was born February 28, 1905 in Peach Bottom, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania. She was the daughter of the late Ella Zeen Lisby Banks and George Oscar Banks. Hattie was the second child of eight in this family. Hattie attended the Mount Sinai A.M.E. Church in Arcadia, Pennsylvania where she was member of the Sunday school. She attended the public school in Plum Hill, Pennsylvania. The family moved to Baltimore, Maryland and she attended Trinity A.M.E. Church. Hattie moved to Harrisburg, Pennsylvania with her cousin and there she joined St. Paul Baptist church. She was a faithful member and held office on the Senior Choir, a Sunday school Teacher and the Missionaries. There she met and married Floyd Jones, a church member and who has preceded her in death. Hattie's health began to fail and moved to Baltimore, Maryland in October 1988 under the care of her niece, Doris I. Harper-Hunt. She later joined Cornerstone Church of Christ under the leadership of Rev. Reginald T. Johnson, Jr., Hattie joined the Cornerstone Seniors and was an active member of the Waxter Center. Aunt Hattie loved to bake rolls, cookies, cakes and pies and would always bring her family baked goods for the holidays. She knitted her family members booties, sweaters and throw covers of all sizes. Hattie loved and enjoyed eating, traveling and having fun. Aunt Hattie loved to take her niece and nephews and great nieces and nephews to Atlantic City during the summer. She was a good sport and would tell us stories of the 1920's. Hattie was known for her feisty manner even in failing health and advancing
