Hattie Ellen Boone was born on June 11, 1930 in Baltimore City to the late Hylant Stewart Sr. and Mary Stewart. She departed this life on March 23, 2017 after a short battle with a sudden illness.

Hattie received her education at Paul Laurence Dunbar High School in Baltimore, Maryland. She began her career in the nursing field as a Nursing Assistant at Baltimore City Hospital. She also worked as a Dialysis Technician where she served until her retirement from Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center.

During her tenure, Hattie received several awards and citations including a Citizen Citation from the city of Baltimore along with an award for Distinguished Service. She was a member of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees Council. The Council recognized Hattie Ellen Boone for 26 years of dedicated service at Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center.

Hattie was very active in her church community, St. Wenceslaus Catholic Church. She served on several ministries and was an original volunteer for the Fitzgerald Outreach Center. Hattie also served as an Usher, Eucharist Minister, Hospitality Worker and a member of the Survivors Ministry. In addition, she was honored by the church with

Hattie enjoyed traveling, shopping, and wearing sassy clothing. Her most pleasurable thing to do was spending time with her family. She was the youngest of five siblings and found great pleasure in supporting her nieces, nephews and especially her own children.

In 1947 Hattie married Joseph Henry Boone, Sr. at St. Francis Xavier Catholic Church in Baltimore City. Joseph and Hattie raised a total of nine children.

She is preceded in death by: her mother and father, Hylant Stewart Sr. and Mary Stewart; her husband, Joseph Henry Boone Sr.; three siblings, Hylant Stewart Jr., Beatrice Ross, and Elizabeth Birt; one child, Dorothy Mae Robinson and two grandchildren, Thelma Robinson and Rodney Harris.
