Family Background: Hattie Elizabeth Horne Jones departed this life on July 11, 2014 at her home surrounded by her husband, son and grandson.

She was married to Clarence Jones, Sr. for fifty-nine years and from this union three children were born: Sharon Dickens, Dumont Jones and Clarence Jones, Jr. Sharon and Dumont preceded her in death and also a granddaughter Shakisha Thomas. She loved to watch various sports on TV and was an avid basketball fan of the Spurs and Wizards. Hattie and Clarence loved to travel to many different places.
