REVEREND HATTIE MAE REDD, daughter of the late Lester and Lizzie Walker, was born on November 2, 1923 in Smokes, South Carolina. She was the oldest of three siblings, two brothers, Rebbie and Freddie Walker, who both Preceded her in death. Reverend Redd departed this life on December 16, 2012 after a brief illness.

Reverend Hattie Mae Redd was educated in Collington County, South Carolina. She furthered her education after relocating to Baltimore, Maryland where she met and married her late husband, John Thomas Redd, Sr. Of this union five children were born.

Reverend Hattie Mae Redd received the Lord Jesus Christ as her personal Savior early in her life at the Lovely Hills Baptist Church in South Carolina and Jamaica Queens, New York, where she also practiced her ministry.
