Hattie Mae Spruell was born on Thursday, June 26, 1930, in Oak City, NC to the late Amos and Arrena Spruell. After being blessed with a life well-lived of 95 years, five months and sixteen days, she transitioned on December 12, 2025 at Sinai Hospice.

Her home was filled with love while being taught Christian values at an early age. Hattie was baptized at the James Mount Pilgrim Baptist Church where she was very active.

She graduated from the W.C. Chance High School. Upon graduation, she relocated to Baltimore, MD where she attended Cortez Peters Business School. She was an employee of the Social Security Administration for over 35 years before retiring as a Supervisor. She formed many deep and lasting friendships at Social Security.

Hattie was a faithful and dedicated member of Trinity Baptist Church for 71 years. She worked in many capacities; Sunday School Teacher in the Jr. Department; Recording Secretary of the Sunday School; worked with the Finance Ministry; Member of Women's and Missions Ministry and organized

both the Youth Choir and the Drama Club. Because of her leadership, she was sought after for advice and assistance over the years. Her teaching led many young people to Christ. Today, some of them are Pastors and Bishops.

She followed her parent's example of "serving God by helping others." Her service ranged from a phone call, a visit to the Nursing Home, rides to a doctor's appointment, the grocery store, etc. She received deep satisfaction from helping and sharing with others.
