



## Haywood Gregory Brown

HAYWOOD GREGORY BROWN was born in Baltimore on March 8, 1950 to Haywood and Dorothy Brown. As a child he grew up in a small African American enclave in Baltimore referred to as Wilson Park. He was a very good athlete having played baseball for the Gentile Colonels and football for the Vikings. Before being hurt he also wrestled at Baltimore Polytechnic Institute from which he graduated 1968. Greg, as he was often referred to, subsequently graduated from Howard University's School of Architecture.

His professional life principally included employment with Harkins Builders. Not satisfied with the limits places by others on his architectural designs, he opened his own company in the form of Citation Builders. The Landscapes of Baltimore City, Baltimore County, and Howard County are enhanced with homes that he designed and built.

His greatest gift however to our world was his son Gregory Darnell Brown and daughter Kara Imani Brown, and by way of his son, Pia Novella Brown, his granddaughter.

Gregory leaves behind not only his children but his mother Dorothy White; his brother, Warren Brown; a sister, Kim Smith; and a legion of nephews, nieces, and friends including but not limited to Curt Anderson, Greg Jackson, Leon Slaughter, Devon Brown, Vernethia Williams and Charlene Graham.
