December 11, 1947 - March 19, 2022

Sergeant Haywood Harris Jr. son of the late Mrs. Mary Francis Harris and Mr Haywood Harris Sr of Charlotte County, Virginia passed away unexpectedly at his home on Saturday, March 19th, 2022, at the age of 74. He was a loving husband, father, grandfather, brother, uncle and son. Stg. Harris was born on Dec 11th, 1947 and grew up in Charlotte County, Virginia. After graduating from Central High School in 1968, he was drafted into the military on June 15th, 1968 serving in the Vietnam War until June 16th, 1970. After returning home, he re-enlisted into the Army Reserves and served for 22 years before retiring in 2002. He joined General Motors in 1973 and worked for the company for 33 years until retiring in 2005. Even in his retirement, he continued to enjoy the act of service while choosing to go back to work at Baltimore Washington International Airport and working for 16 years until retiring in 2021. In his spare time, he enjoyed spending time with his family, traveling with his wife, working in his yard, and reading his bible. Stg.
