HAZEL E. (ZANT) BURLOCK was born on April 24, 1924 to James A. Thomas, Sr. and Alethea (Ingram) Thomas. She was the eldest of 14 children adopted by Caesar and Bessie Zant after the death of their father left them orphaned.

Hazel was educated in the public schools of Baltimore county. She trained as a nurse's aide and worked at Taylor Manor in Ellicott City. Throughout her adult life, she attended courses and received certificates from Anne Arundel Community College in geriatric nursing assistant. She also transported children for the Head Start Program and provided private duty nursing. For several years, Hazel worked in the Department of Aging and Disabilities Senior Nutrition Program serving meals to senior citizens at Pine Wood and Glen Square. She was a senior Aide in the AAWDC Senior Community Service Employment Program. She worked until June of 2011.
