



## Hazel F. Robinson

December 19, 1929 - June 30, 2019

Hazel Frances Robinson, better known as “Jack” by her family as a young girl, was born December 19, 1929, in Wade, North Carolina to Mary Lou and Sylvester Robinson, Sr. She departed this life on June 30, 2019.

The family moved to Baltimore when she was eight years old. Hazel attended public schools in both North Carolina and Baltimore, Maryland. After graduating from Douglass High School in 1945, she attended Coppin Teachers College.

Upon graduation in 1950, Hazel pursued a Master’s Degree at New York University. During this time in our history, the State of Maryland did not admit African-American students to higher learning, so the State provided a full grant to cover the cost of tuition.

Hazel was an excellent first grade teacher and enjoyed her job very much. After twenty-nine years of service to Baltimore Public schools, she retired, due to some health issues.

Hazel joined St. Katherine’s Church in 1938 and enjoyed attending Sunday school. Having Mr. Joseph Briscoe as a teacher was a great pleasure. As she grew older, Hazel took part in a variety of church activities.

As a young woman, Hazel enjoyed traveling, most notably the trips to Hawaii and Western Europe. She also loved animals, as we can all remember her three Dalmatians. Reading and playing the piano were also activities she enjoyed in her spare time.

Hazel is preceded in death by her sister, Merion Grandison.

Hazel is survived by sisters, Thelma Walker and Evelyn Van Hook; brother, Sylvester Robinson, Jr.; nieces, Patricia Walker and Brenda Robinson, Cynthia Yelverton and Sharon Hammer; nephews, Nathaniel Gardner, Kenneth Walker, Sylvester Robinson III, Sidney Grandison and Ronald Walker; and a host of great nieces and nephews, other relatives and friends.
