HENRY ARMSTEAD, JR was born on September 17, 1973 to Thomasine Haley and Henry Armstead, Sr. in Baltimore, Maryland. He departed this life suddenly on August 21, 2012.

Henry was raised in Christian home and attended New Faith Deliverance Revival Center at an early age He received his education through the Baltimore City Public School System and his Commercial Drivers License (CDL) from All-State Career.
