Henry L. Warren, Jr. son of the late Henry L. Warren and Elizabeth Warren, was born on February 12, 1929 in Anstead, West Virginia. He departed this life on March 3, 2003 after lengthy illness. In 1945, he became a member of Lawson Chapel Church in Alton, Virginia. He received his education at Simmons High School in West Virginia and graduated in 1947 from Halifax Training School in Halifax, Virginia. Upon completion of his education he worked in the coalmines in West Virginia from 1947-1951, interrupted by serving two years in the United States Army from 1951-1953. In 1954, a daughter, Shirley, was born to Henry and Zelma Barksdale. In 1954, he relocated to Baltimore, Maryland to attend Morgan State College. He became a member of Mount Pleasant Baptist Church and later renewing his faith, became a member of Wayland Baptist Church. In 1954, he married the former Lucy Marie Barksdale. Out of this union four children were born; one son, Lewis, who preceded him to the grave, one daughter, Debra, and twin daughters, Annitta and Annetta. 1955-1956, He was employed by Bethlehem Steel in Maryland. In 1956, he accepted a position with the Baltimore Transit Company, later named the Mass Transit Administration from where he retired in 1995. Henry was the historian of the family. He was truly devoted to his children and shared his life, love and friendship with all that knew him. He made numerous friends wherever he went and will be sincerely missed by all that knew him.
